Countries with Comprehensive Flexible Rules



Israel, Jordan, Egypt

- Comprehensive product coverage
- Product of country;
- 35% regional value content (RVC)
 - Double substantial transformation (cutting or knitting to shape + assembly)
- Direct shipment







Fabric/ Yarn/ Leather Components Israel Finished Good Israel India



GSP Product List Limited

- Textile & leather bags, wallets, etc.
- Leather gloves, belts
- Sports gloves
- Silk handkerchiefs and scarves
- Pillows/comforters not cotton
- Other limited apparel, bags, footwear and textile articles
- Issue of periodic lapse / untimely Congressional renewal



Countries with Tariff Preference Levels



Tariff Preference Level

- Same as tariff rate quota (TRQ)
- A certain quantity of goods can enter during an annual period and receive a reduced rate or duty free treatment even though they don't meet the tariff shift rules
- Foreign fiber, yarn or fabric, NOT components (except AGOA)
- No foreign cutting or knitting to shape





Mexico


- TPL 1: Cotton or Man-Made Fiber Apparel (exceptions)
- TPL 2: Wool Apparel (exceptions)
- Cotton or Man-Made Fiber Fabric, Made-up Textile Articles, Stuffed Articles
 - TPL 5: sublimit for knit fabric & certain made-ups
 - TPL 6: sublimit for woven fabric & certain made-ups
- TPL 7: Cotton or Man-Made Fiber Staple Yarn





Canada

- TPL 1: Cotton or Man-Made Fiber Apparel
 - TPL 2: sublimit for foreign fabric
- TPL 3: Wool Apparel
 - TPL 4: sublimit for men's/boys' suits
- TPL 5: Cotton or Man-Made Fiber Fabric, Made-up Textile Articles, Stuffed Articles
 - TPL 6: sublimit for woven fabric & certain made-ups,
 - TPL 7: sublimit for knit fabric & certain made-ups
- TPL 8: Cotton or Man-Made Fiber Staple Yarn





Chile

- Cotton or Man-Made Fiber Fabric (ch 52, 54, 55, 58, 60)
- Cotton or Man-Made Fiber Apparel





Haiti

- All Woven Apparel
 - Expires 9/30/2025
- Knit Apparel other than certain men's and boys' upper body knits
 - Expires 9/30/2025





African Growth & Opportunity Act

- All apparel from lesser developed countries
 - Designated AGOA textile beneficiary countries other than South Africa
 - https://agoa.info/about-agoa/country-eligibility.html
- 7% of SME of all apparel imported into the US the prior year
- Expires 9/30/2025

Haiti

- CAFTA-DR single transformation garments (see later slides)
- Certain woven sleepwear bottoms
- Certain knit apparel (not men's/boys' tops excluded from TPL)
- Textile or plastic outer surface bags
- Certain hats
- Certain made-up textile articles
- No limits
- Expires 9/30/2025



USMCA

- Certain footwear permits foreign uppers and assembly only, without a regional value content

Best Place to Make...

- Textile Bags of 4202 (17.6%) CAFTA-DR, Korea, Panama
- Brassieres (16.9%) USMCA, CAFTA-DR, Peru, Colombia, Panama
- Footwear (up to 37%) CAFTA-DR







Items with most flexibility in multiple FTAs

- Cotton bags of 4202 (up to 17.6%)
- Leather bags of 4202 (up to 10%)
- Bags of plastic sheeting without textile backing of 4202 (20%)
- Leather apparel & accessories of 4203 (up to 14%)
- Garments of heading 5903 coated fabric (7.1%)
- Hats (up to 10%)







Short Supply

Certain fiber/yarn/fabric determined to NOT be available in commercial quantities in a timely manner and can therefore come from outside the Parties



Countries with fixed list

- Mexico
- Canada
- Chile
- Singapore
- Australia
- Morocco
- Bahrain
- Oman
- Korea





Fixed List of Materials for Apparel

- Woven Silk
- Woven Linen
- Cotton Velveteen
- Fine Wale Corduroy
- Harris Tweed
- Certain Woven Fabrics of Fine Animal Hair
- Certain Lightweight, High Thread Count Polyester/Cotton Woven Fabrics
- Certain Lightweight, High Thread Count Broadwoven Fabrics Used in the Production of Men's or Boys' Shirts
- Certain coated fabrics of chapter 59



Countries & Goods with Flexible List

- CAFTA-DR (ch 50-63 and 9404.90)
- Peru (4202 textile, 50-63 and 9404.90)
- Colombia (4202 textile, 50-63 and 9404.90)
